The Cart and the Horse

INTRODUCTION: So, what does James mean? Saving faith not only acknowledges, it believes and trusts in the leading of the object of faith-Jesus. I am going to use an old formula by Calvin and other Reformers about the elements of true faith: Notitia, Assensus and Fiducia, so we might get the horse and cart in order.

CONCLUSION: I believe James is speaking to believers not to let their faith retreat from a wholistic, whole body, soul and spirit faith, to an intellectual exercise in Notitia. Make sure the horse of faith is a strong and healthy one, not just from the neck up, but down through the heart to the tip of he hooves, and the cart will fall in line absolutely correctly. You will have a faith worth sharing with your family, friends and neighbors and it will be whole and winsome to many.
